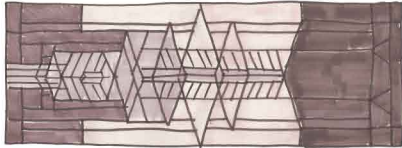

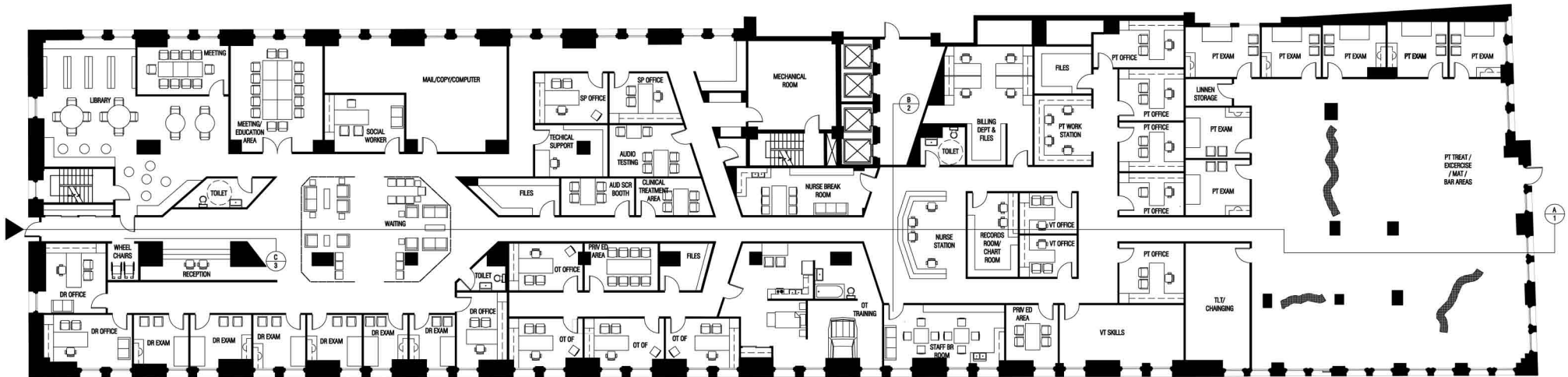
PARTI DIAGRAM



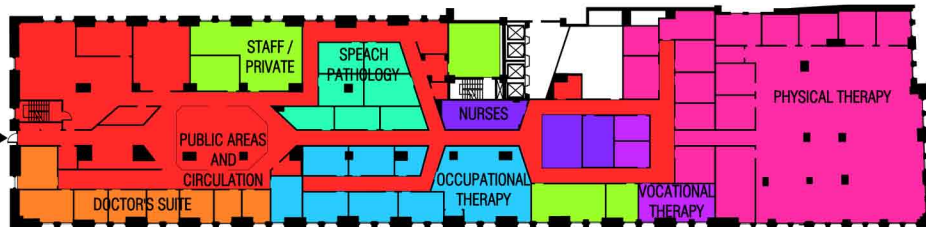

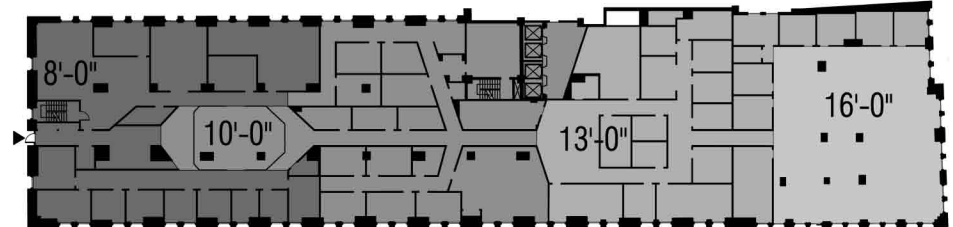
WAITING ROOM PERSPECTIVE



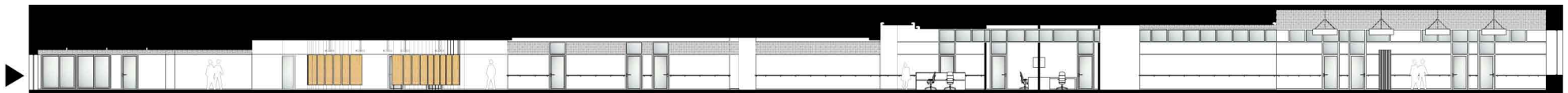
FLOORPLAN
