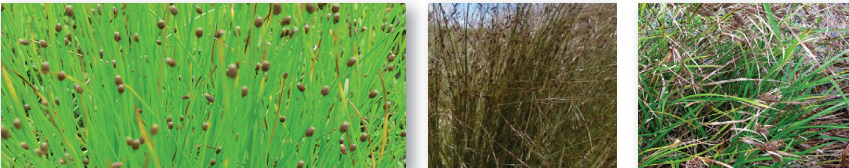

notes

Common Oats and Annual Rye should be broadcast after excavation to help reduce erosion and increase aesthetic appeal.

Cluster Blue Flag and Smooth Rose Mallow close to banks nearest flood plain in visible areas.
