MCCUE FLOWER MARKET

Faneuil Hall-Boston, MA





McCue's Flower Shop has been an Icon in Faneuil Hall's out-door marketplace for more than 30 years. Part of the redevelopment of the old marketplace in the late 1970's, it was due for a revitalization in the early 1990's. As part of the Rouse Group's leasehold improvement requirements, PHB Architects, lead by Paul Bourbeau, AIA, designed new out-door trellises which linked the exterior footprint of the building with the inner marketplace courtyard.

The design required the introduction of a new centerpiece to the outdoor garden display. A central gazebo was developed which tied the exterior trellises together and created visual structure to what was once just a haphazard arrangement of flower displays. In addition to the hardscape, flower displays, tables and benches were designed to provide a cohesive design language which helps "brand" the flower shop amongst the variety of retail establishments throughout the marketplace.
