

Bloom Carroll Middle School



Concept:

The central wall acts as a filter for the activities in and around the building. Interior finishes and organization of spaces reflect the movement and mixing of people and flow of energy.



Cafeteria & Media Center:

This school building will be used as a community hub, and therefore the cafeteria doubles as a lobby space for evening functions. At night, the storefront displays those activities and the light from within is a beacon for the neighborhood. The media center—located at the terminus of the main axis—repeats materials and motifs used in the entry lobby, and opens onto the field of geothermal wells behind the school.
