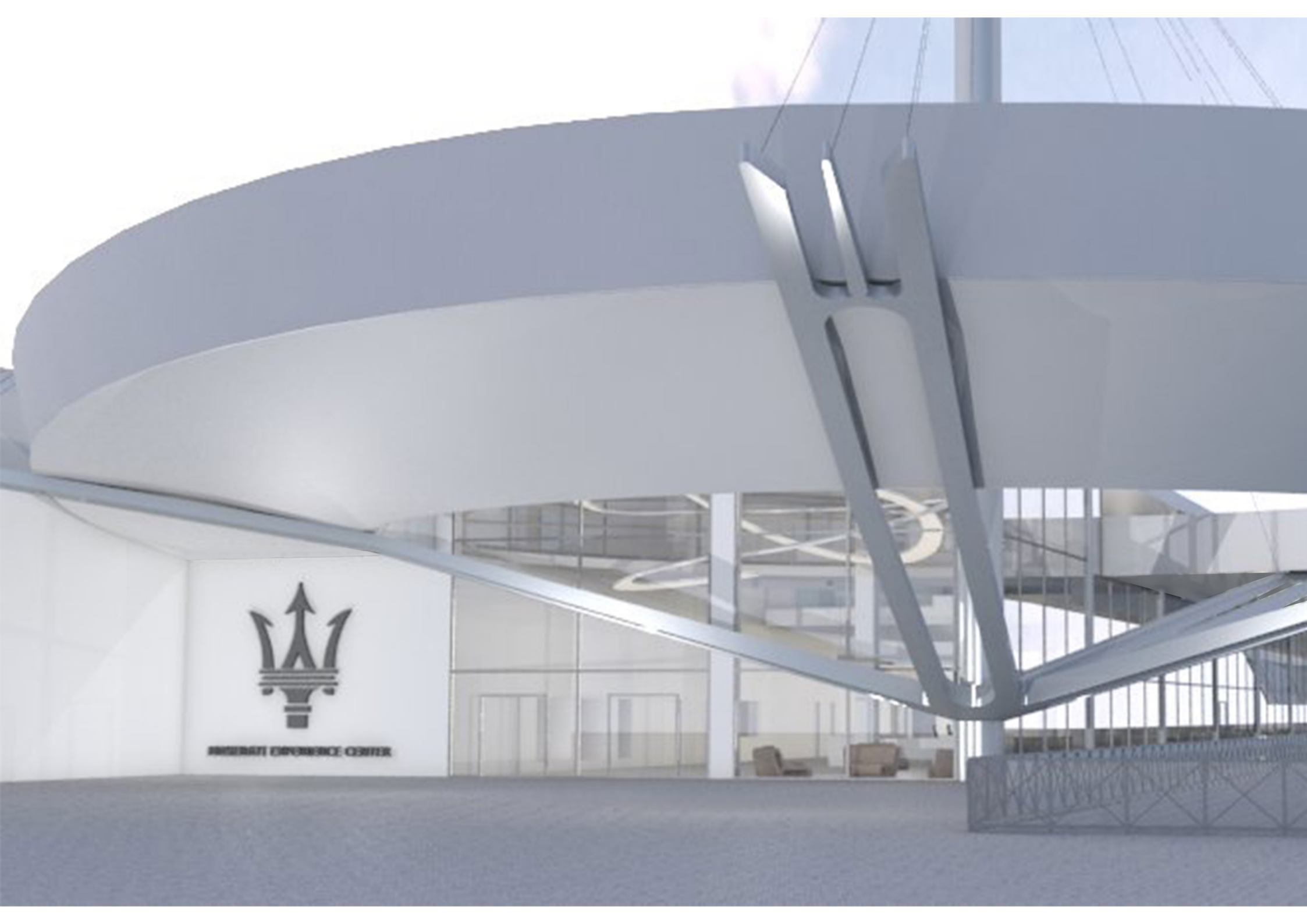

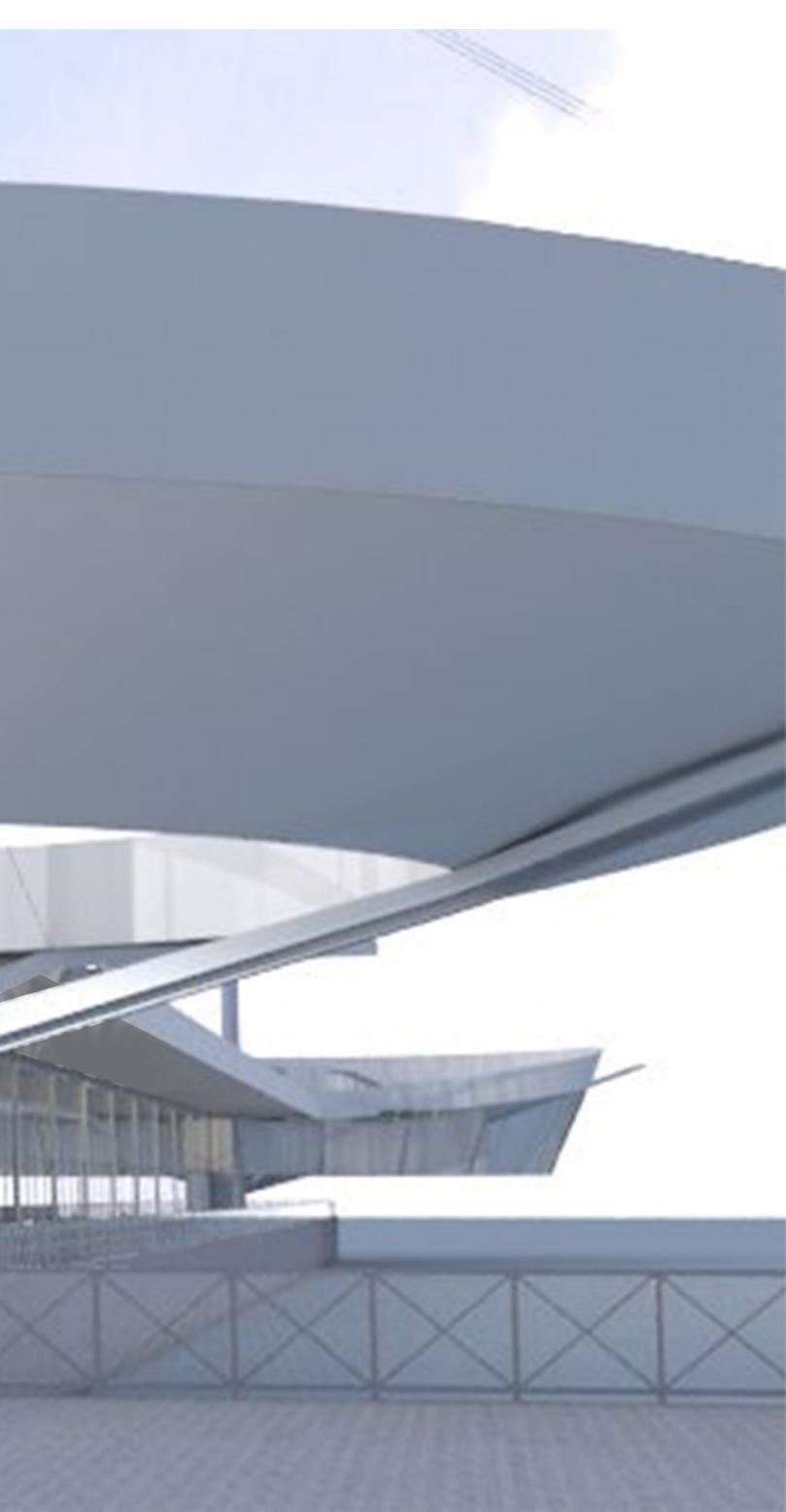

# MASERATI EXPERIENCE CENTER

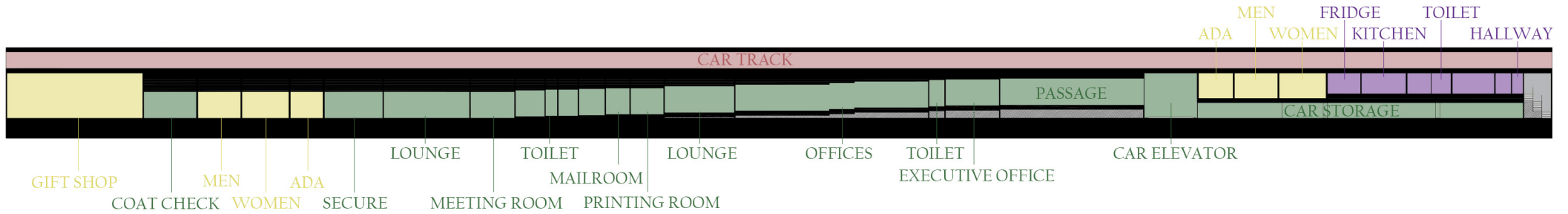

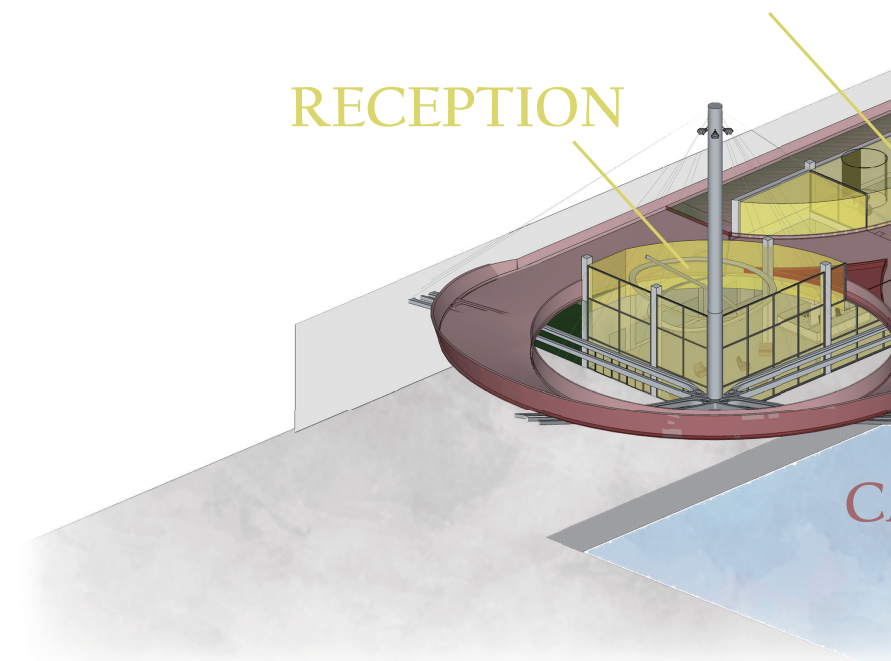
The overall area is divided into private and public, interior and semi-exterior with one linear cut. The add-on areas are for car track and restaurant.

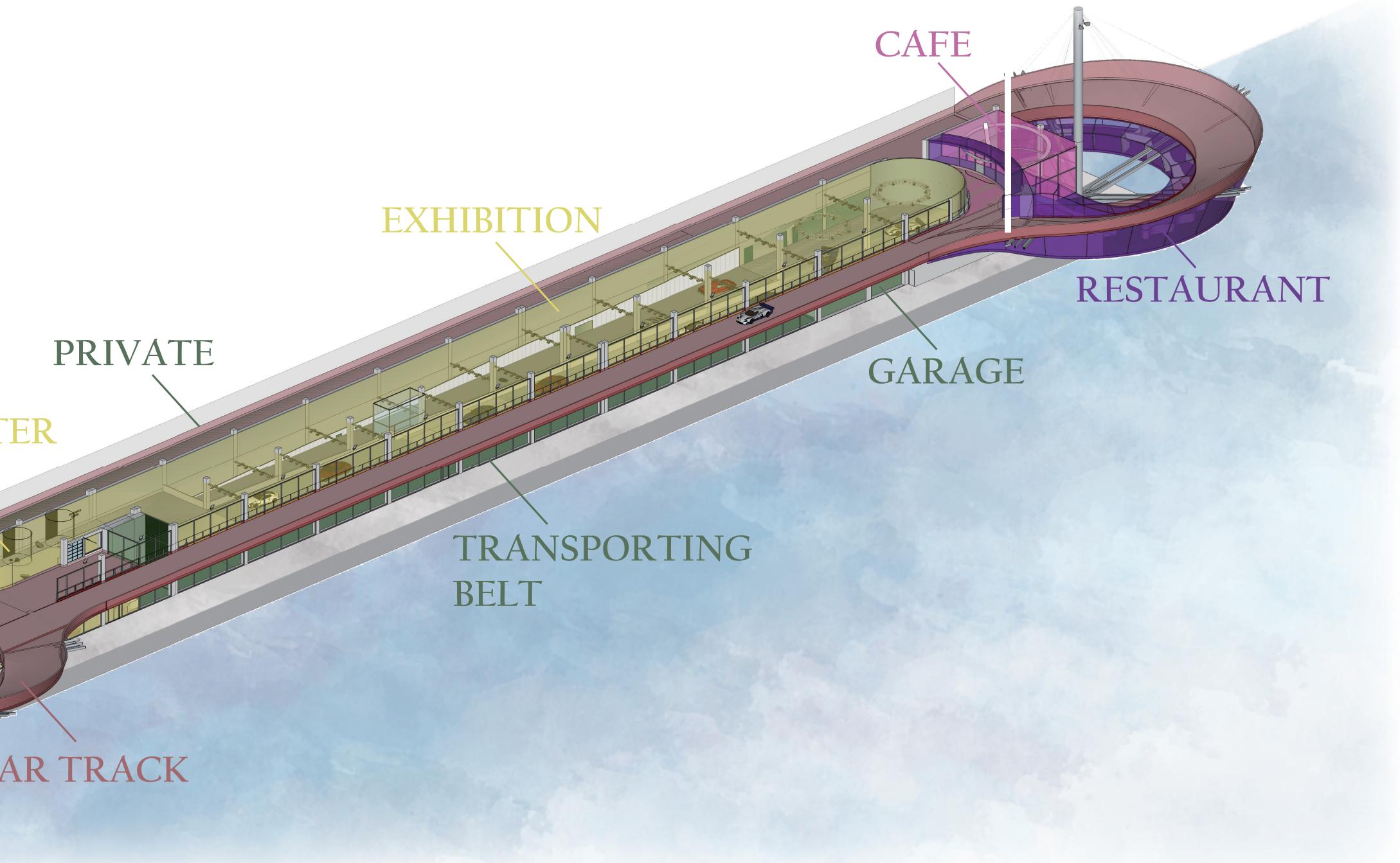
Since the center is on the river, the structure of the two ends mimic the boats and it is also inspired by the wheel of Maserati vehicle.

# TWIST HOTEL

The design concept of Twist Hotel is based on Dan Brown's novel "Deception Point". Deception Point is a thriller novel, which is about scientific discovery, unfriendly relationship between father and daughter, political scheme, and murders. Therefore, the hotel design is based on the feeling of dark, insecure, and deceptive. The hotel is meant to depict the conflicting and the cruel faces of the book in an abstract way on the first floor. Customers could get into the twisted translucent concrete tunnel, and experience the feeling of being unknown and exposed.

Since the first floor's design is more dark and mysterious, the second floor is the opposite. It is comfortable and bright, which indicates the happy ending at the end of the book.



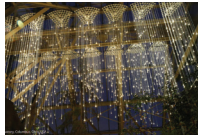

The concept of the Factory is based on the idea of the future industry. Nowadays, the jeans' factories are more and more automatic. So does the "Factory".

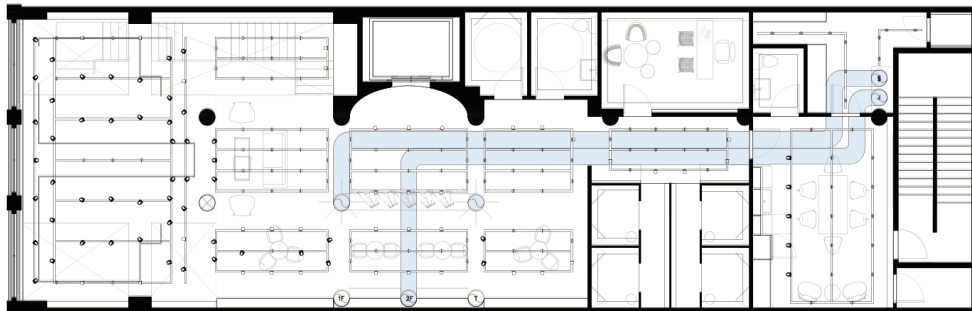
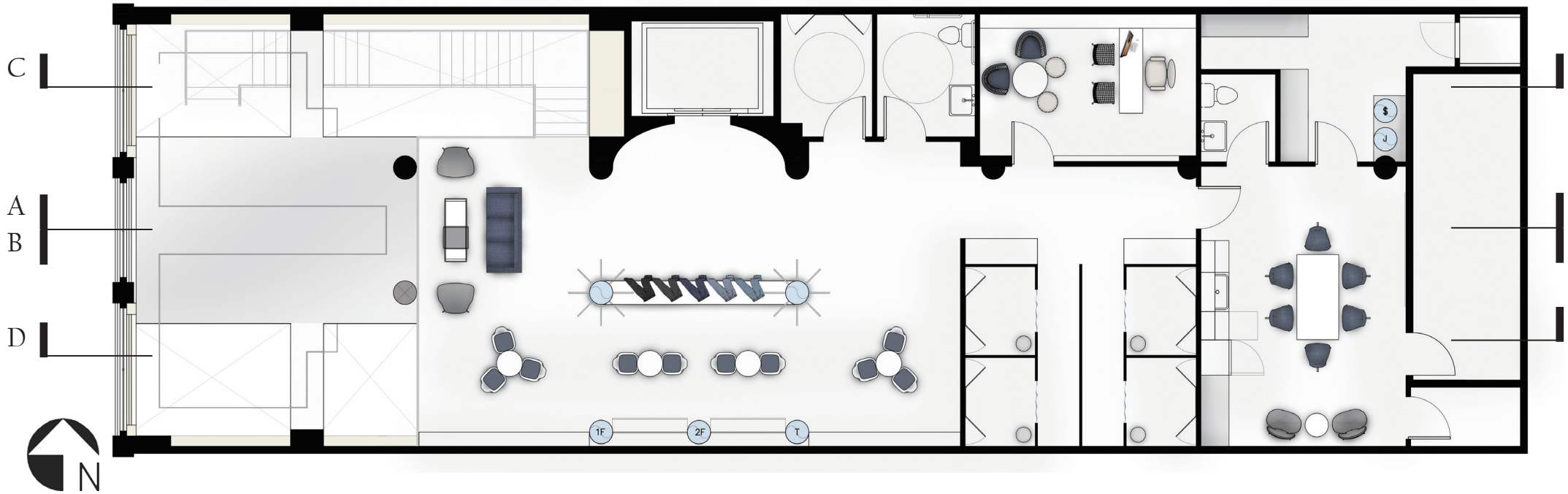
It has a carousel automatic jeans' display, which rotates non-stop from the window display on the first floor, to the second floor's window display, and the runway on the second floor.

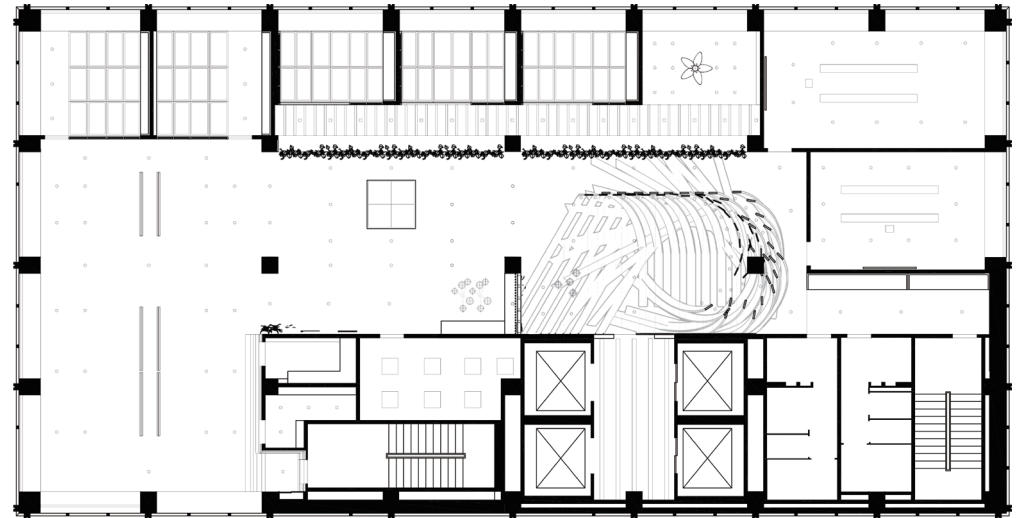


World Wildlife Fund is one of the worldwide non-profit organizations which is dedicated in conserving nature and reducing the most pressing threats to the diversity of life on Earth.

area is designed to be able to set a large size TV for the couple's desire of big screen.

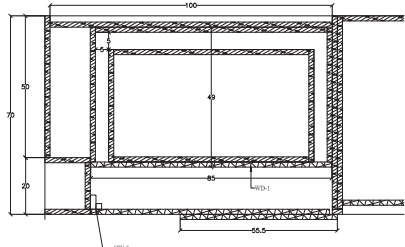
