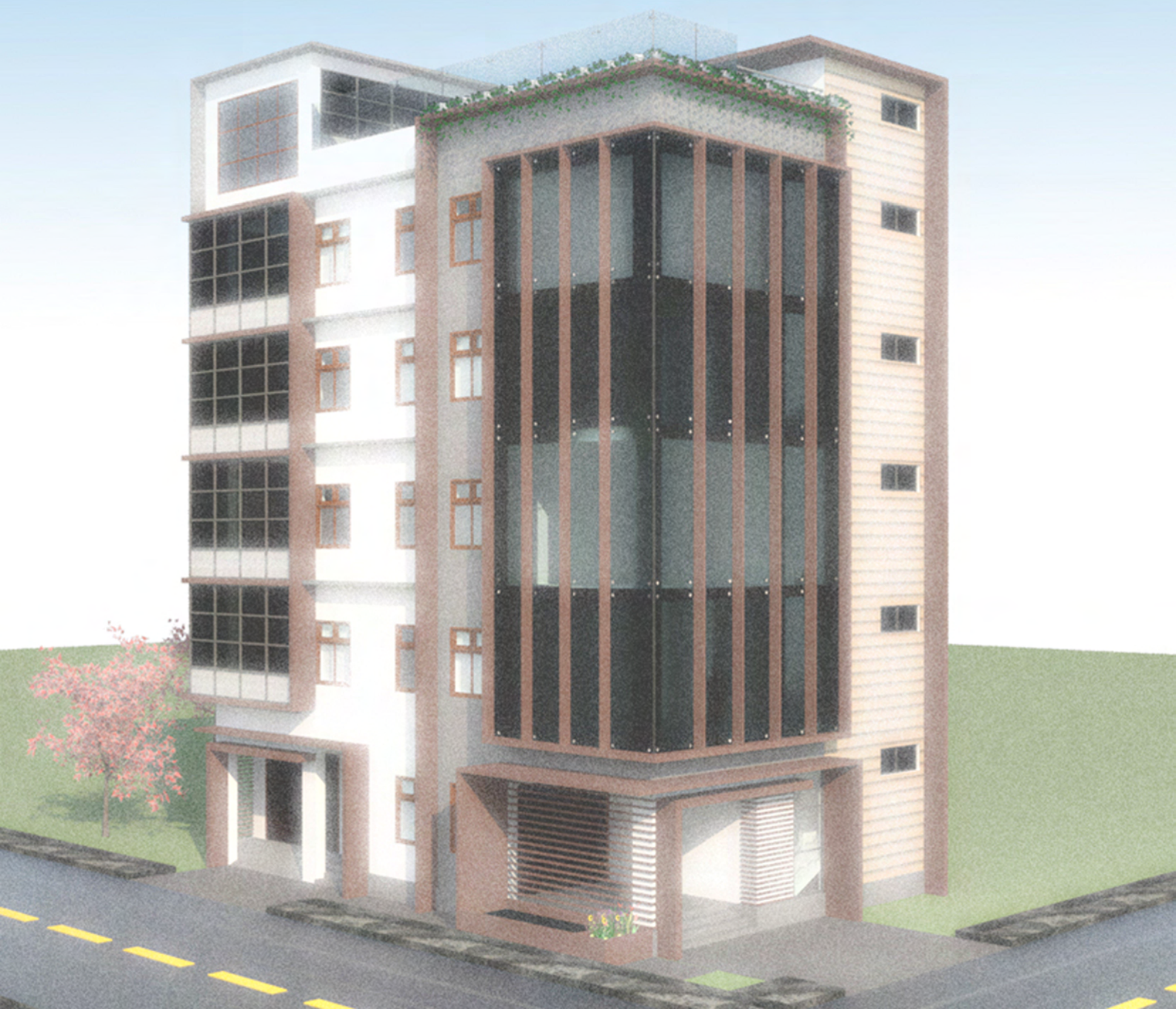

This two and a half storeyed house was designed with a huge porch to add volume to the house as the client wanted it to have a grand and welcoming feeling although it is only 40' wide and 40'.long.

Wood and natural clay tiles are used as the main aesthetical material.

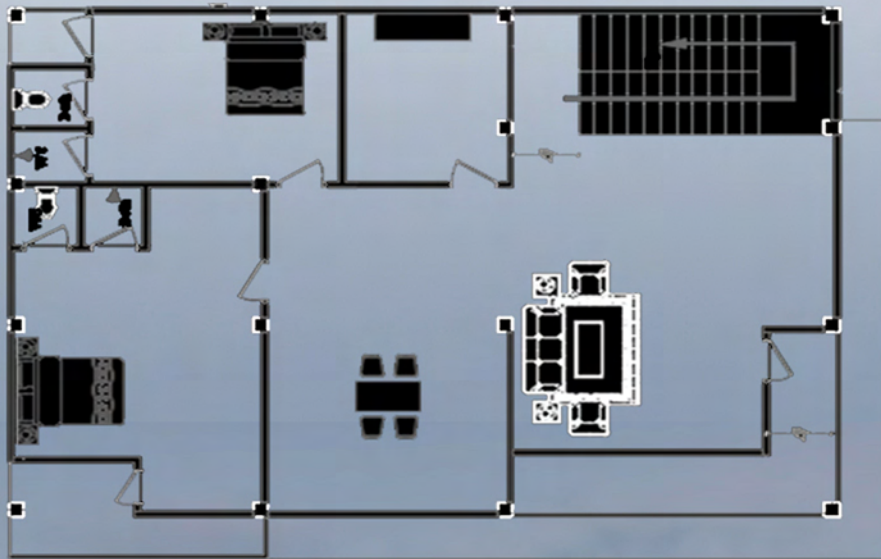
The balcony on the second floor is covered partially by the wooden planks which also can be used as a roof garden for relaxation purpose.



This basic contemporary designed building is one of my freelance projects where the client wanted to have some shops in the ground floor to rent and the other three floors to be identical.

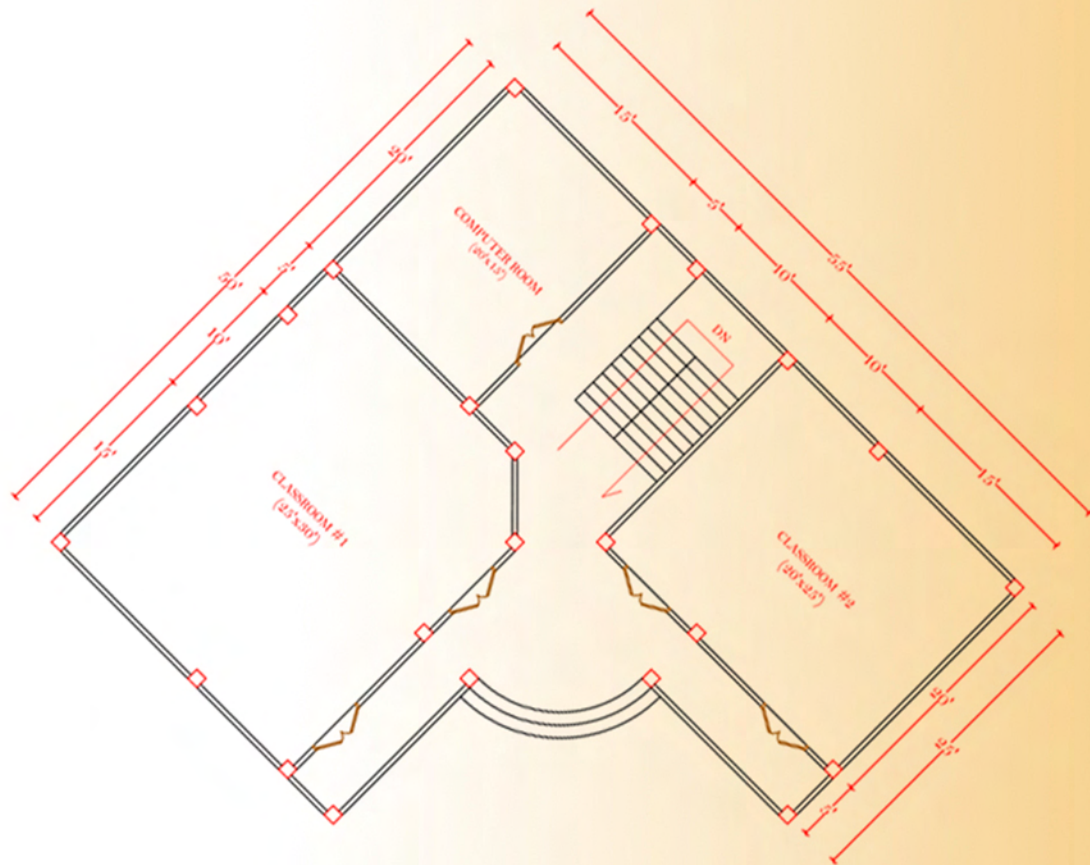
Since the facade is facing the east side, I added wooden frames at the east and south in order to cover the hot sun of Mandalay as possible.

The verandahs can be seen in almost all bedrooms to enjoy the amazing view of the surrounding and for the leisure in the evening,



This simple academic building was designed with a refreshing look for the middle school students.

The small and high porch is added a few feet lower than the ceiling height for the aesthetic purpose and for labelling the school name.





This single story house was designed in a colonial + modern myanmar architecture as it will be constructed in Pyin Oo Lwin; a town with popular colonial buildings.

It includes a balcony in the gable with three gabled dormers on each side of the roof enabling the natural sunlight.

The front porch was designed with myanmar style handrails and woodern patterns making the whole building style as a mix of colonial + modern myanmar architecture style.
