Water

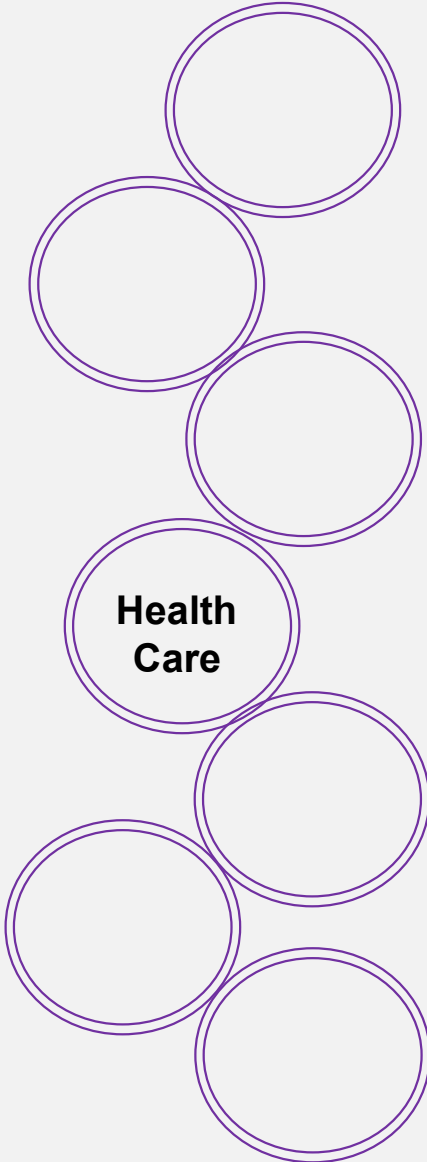
1. 20,000 water glasses are put out on tables and wasted in restaurants.

- 3.Healthy and organic

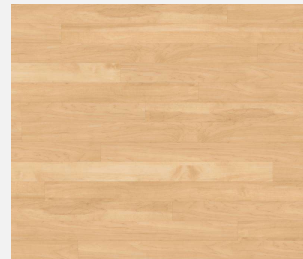
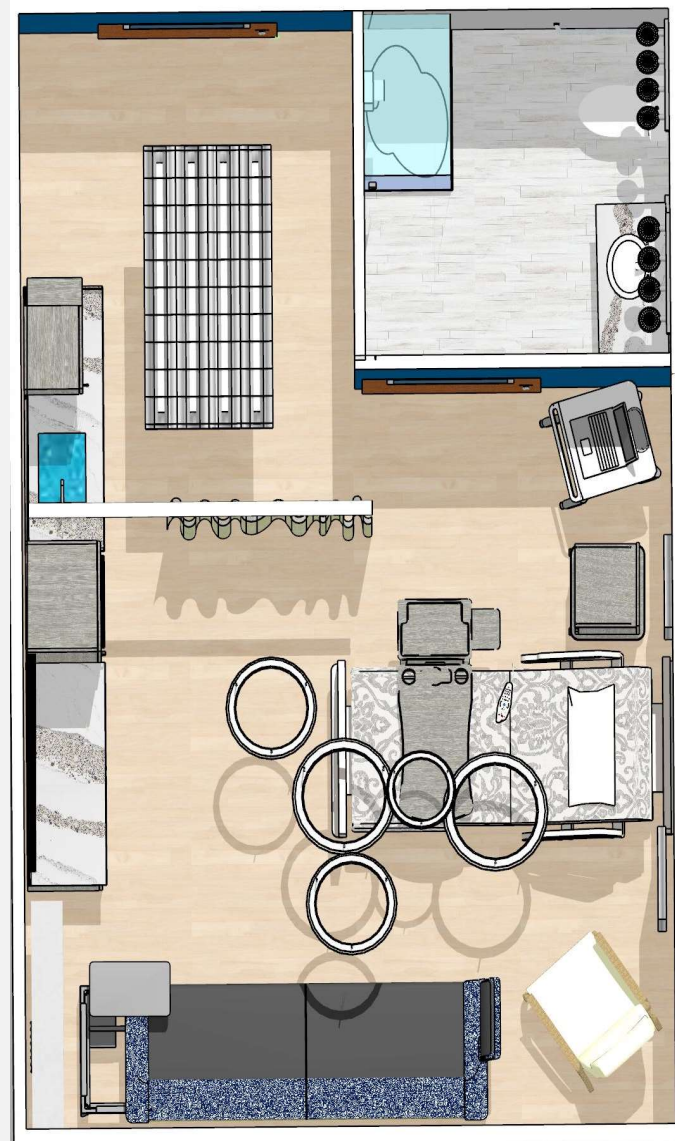

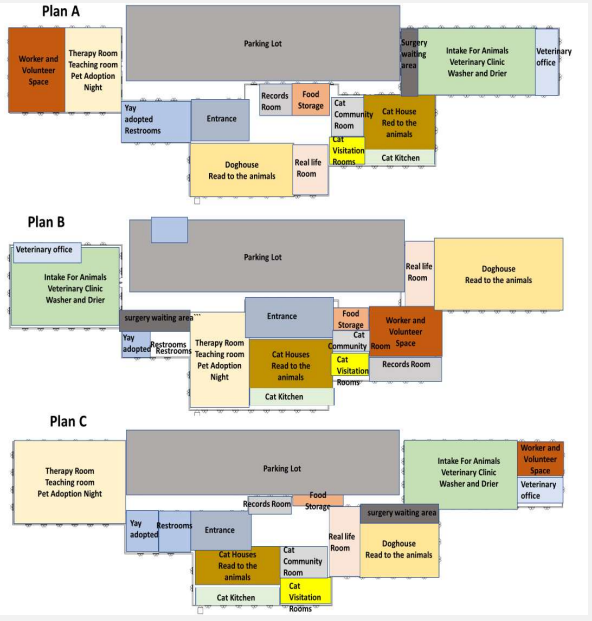

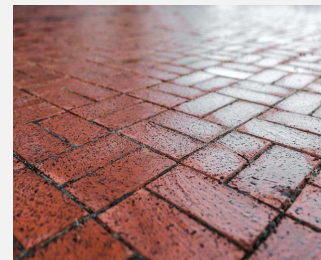
