HISTORIC INTERVENTION IN THE URBAN HISTORICAL CONTEXT-ACTIVITY HOUSE

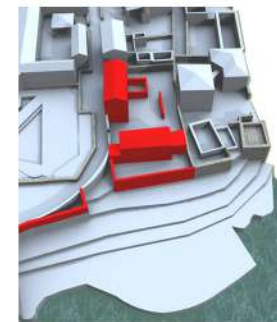
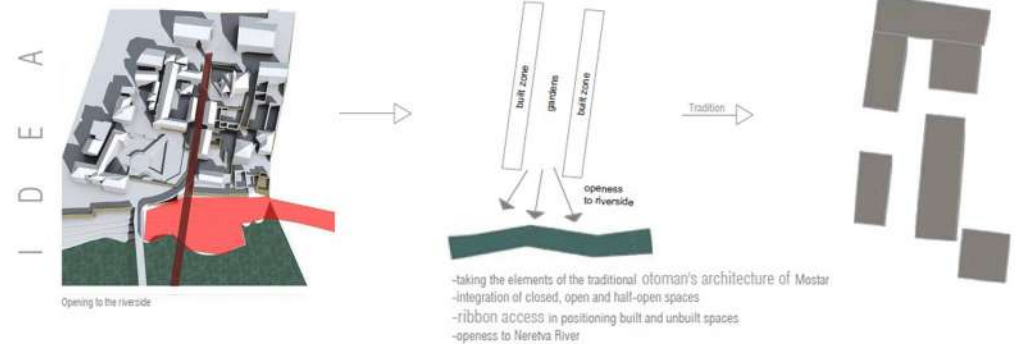
Mostar, Bosnia and Herzegovina

The project was exhibited in cultural center Abrasevic, Mostar, BIH, 2012.

The project was designed as the part of the subject 'Historic intervention in the urban historical context' and it is located in Roznamedžijina mahala in Mostar (BIH). On the site there are several objects which have sacred and enviromental values and they belong to the historical urban context of the city of Mostar. The plot on which this conceptual project is located is near Bunur bridge and the rocky coast of the Neretva River which was once used as a place for swimming. Since the war in 1992 until today, there were built two houses that have no value and are almost in ruinous condition. The new project envisages the demolition of these buildings since they have no any value and making the new project with the shape and form that will fit into the existing urban context and with the right function that will make this part of the Mostar attractive again.

The basic idea of the project is using the typical and traditional elements of Mostar construction and architecture through the modern architectural interventions. This includes the design that will contain these characteristic elements of Mostar construction such as inner courtyards, greenery and water interactions, the use of traditional materials such as wood and stone and building a larger number of smaller residential units.

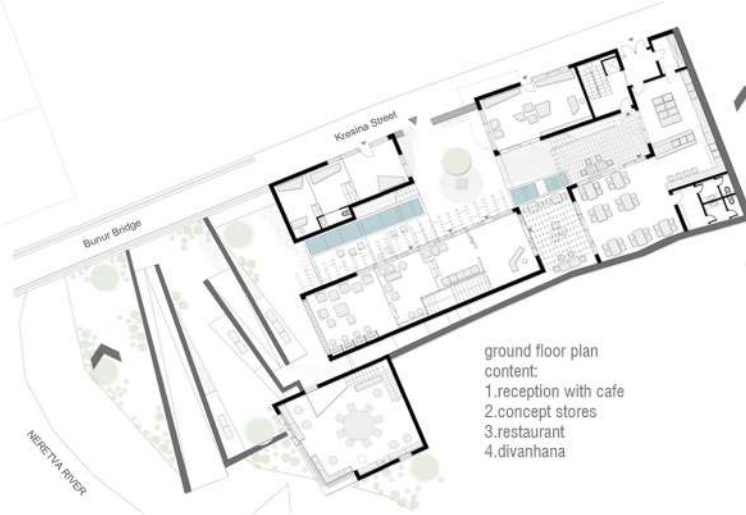
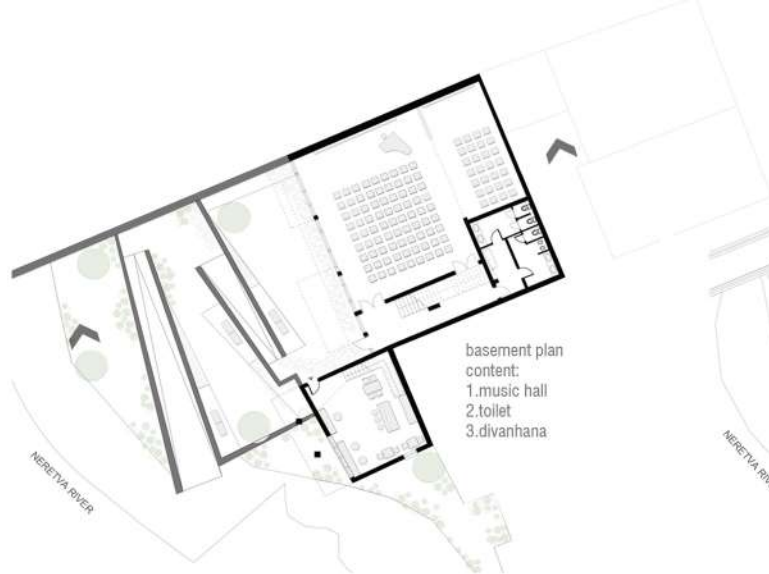
The project is called Activity house due to its multifunctionality. The object is open to all tourists and citizens and it offers a number of facilities such as multimedia hall for various cultural events, restaurants, common areas, commercial facilities, hostel and a small restaurant for eating. The building has ramps associated with the rocky coast of the Neretva River, which is planned to be used for swimming. Multifunctionality of object gives the possibility to be used by a large number of people and makes this destination of the city more useful.

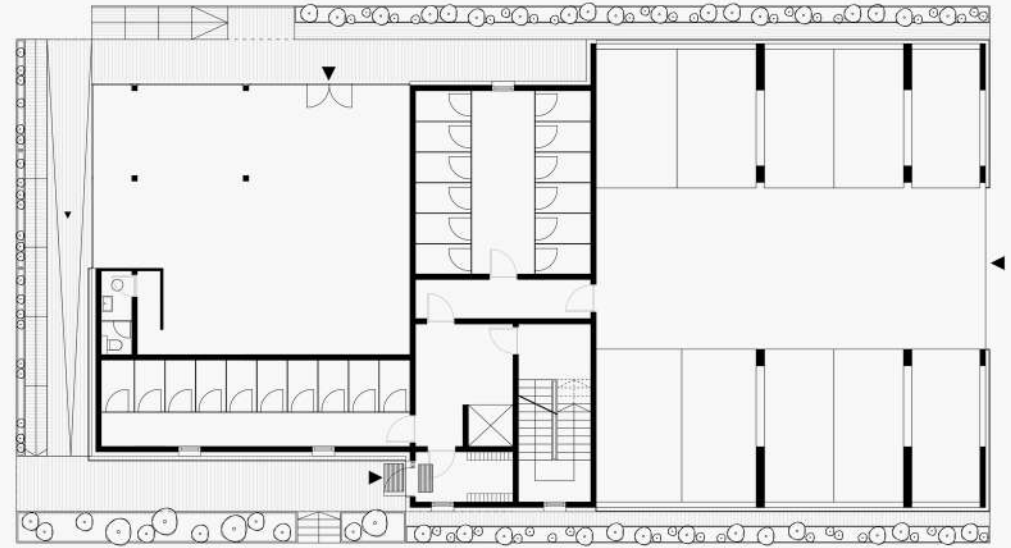

GROUND FLOOR PLAN

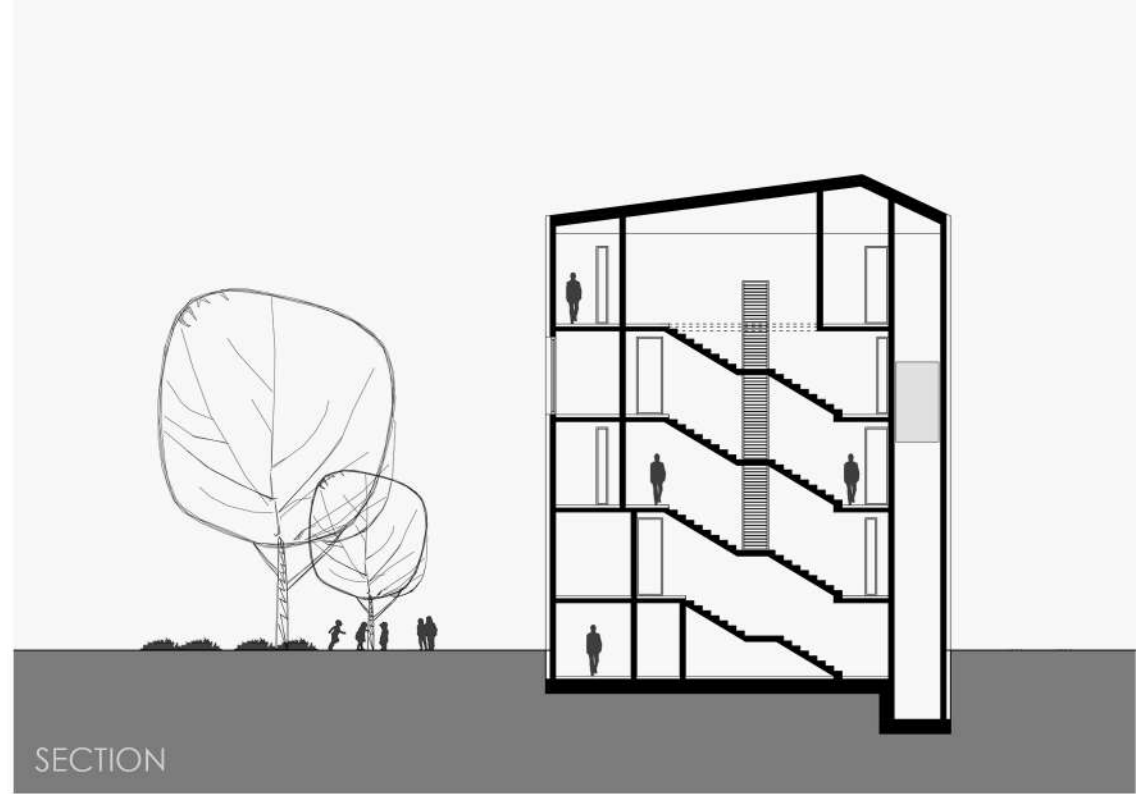

SPORT CENTER 'DARIVA'

Sport centre 'Dariva' is located in very attractive green zone in Sarajevo that people use for relaxation, walking and mountain climbing. However, there are still some disadvantages like lack of urban furniture, lack of attractive content that could bring more people to the location, and lack of spaces where sportists can take a break and have drink.

One of the main aims of sport center project is to activate this location more and to bring new contents for both sportists and people who want to relax. Since the location is surrounded by beautiful nature, design of the sport center tends to incorporate with natural environment also by using mostly wood for material.

Sport center has two football spots one of which can be used for children trainings, place for audience, rooms for media and administration, cafe and restaurant with garden. Sportists have their separate change rooms and toilets. The project is designed completely according to UEFA rules for architectural design and dimensions.

I was involved in making the complete architectural design, blueprints and 3D visualisation for the project.







APARTHOTEL 'JAHORINA'

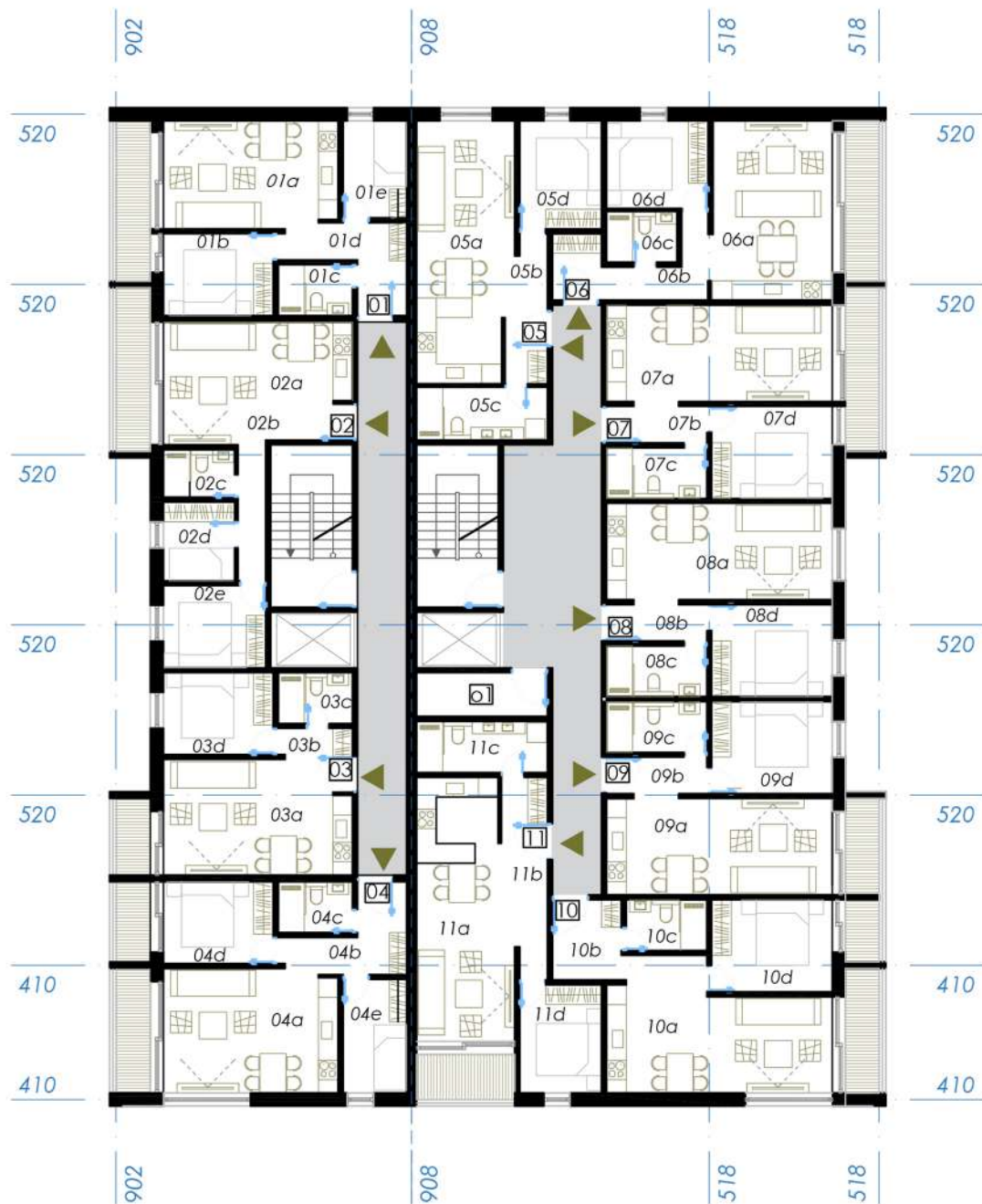

FLOOR PLAN

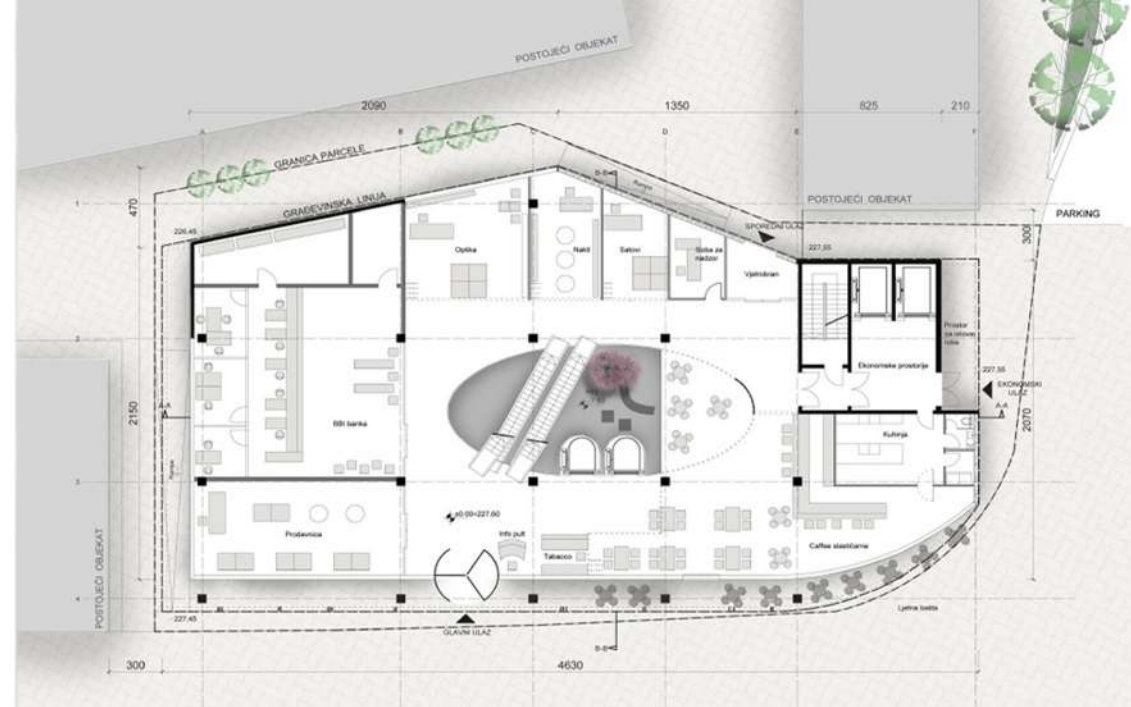


BBI GALERY SHOPPING MALL Studio BP

OFFICE 'DEVLOGIC'

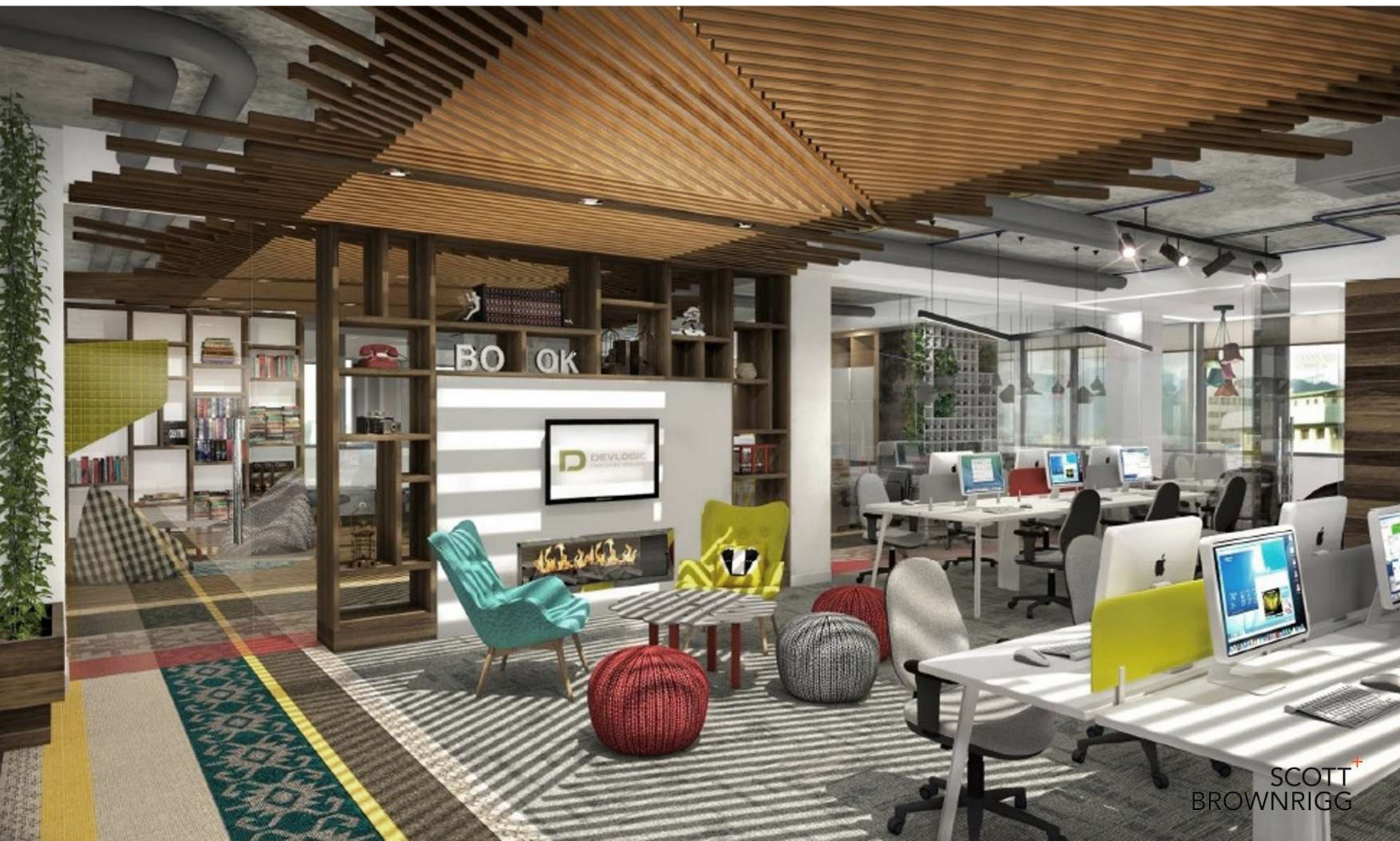

CAFE 'AT MEJDAN'

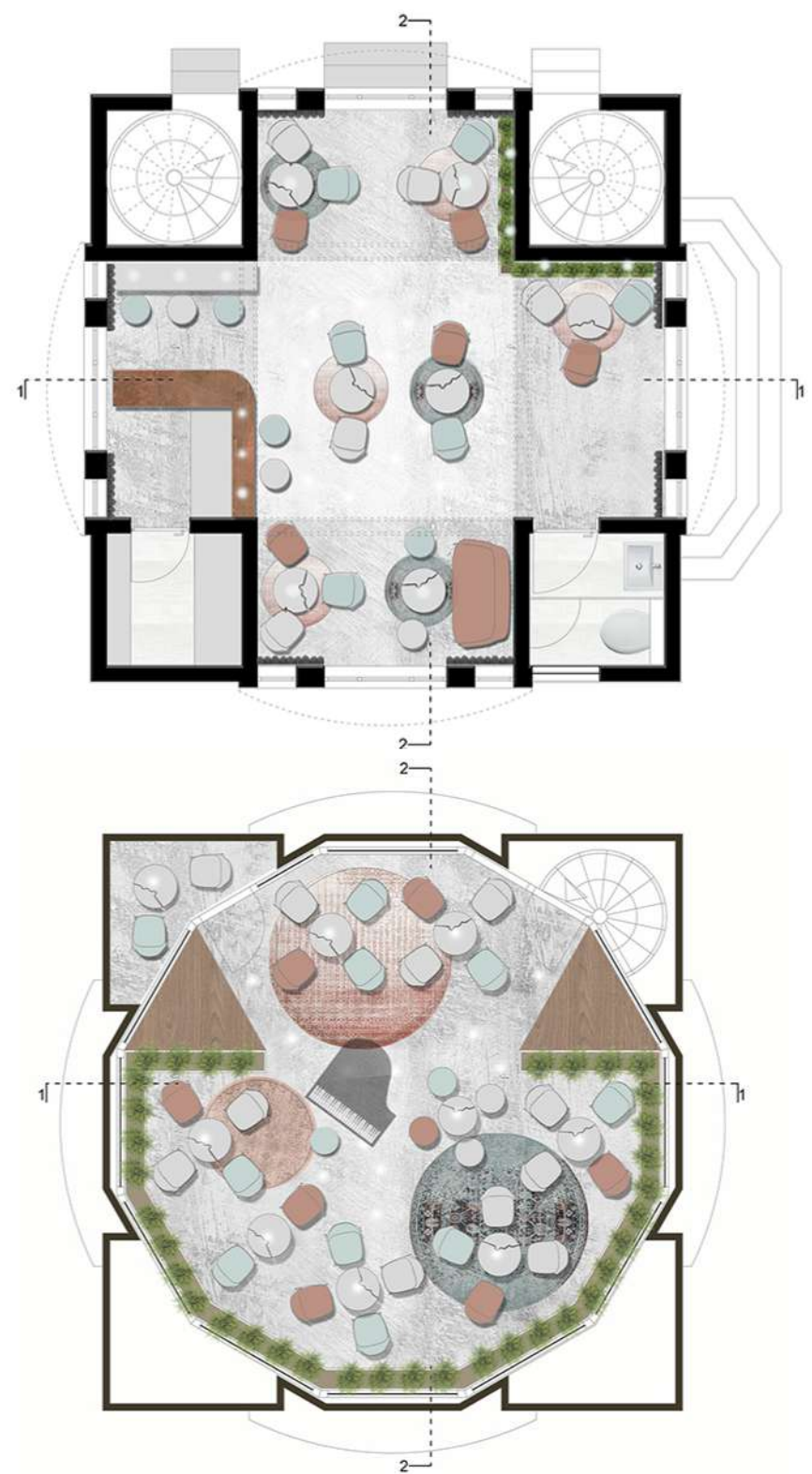

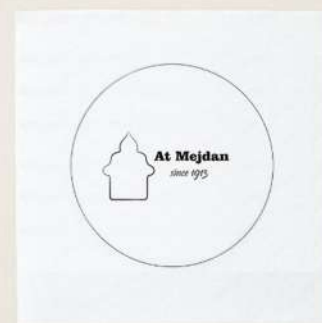
The project took place in an old musical pavilion located in a beautiful park in the old part of the Sarajevo city. Pavillion was build during Austro-Hungarian period where there were four pavillions of this kind, and this one is the only one survived. The pavillion was not used enough and needed some new function that would give him back attractiveness and through which the object would be maintained and prevented from possible future degradations.

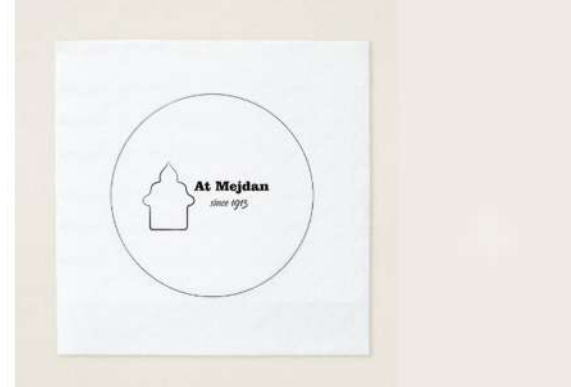
New project proposes a redesign of interior that would give him back his primary function- place where people meet and listen to the music. The dark and heavy wood in excisting site is refreshed with white concrete floor in combination with light pastel colours of furniture and copper which re-mains of traditional bosnian materials that were used for making certain types of furniture and accessories.

Upper floor has octagonal shape and is designed with the same color scheme as ground floor with the space where people can play and listen to the music. Since the pavillion is located in the park, project proposes his integration into interior as well, so we see presence of the plants on the ceiling of ground floor and between glass panels of upper floor.

The project is one step more towards preservation of all historical valuable objects of Sarajevo that are 'speaking' about the diverse history of the city. The project is in process of realisation.







FASHION STORE 'HAVE 2 HAVE'

Small fashion store is located in the old town in the heart of Sarajevo. Interior is done in very bright pastel colors in combination with rose gold metal details. All furniture is handmade in minimalistic style. Shop has three parts: one is entrance with representative display pult and lightnings, in the second part there is sitting area and in third part are cabins. All parts are surrounded with minimalistic shelves for exposing clothes. Shop has little storage too. Brand logo is made in three variations so that it can be applicable for different things such as paper bags, visit cards, catalogues and similar. Project is realised in 2017.

APARTMENT INTERIOR DESIGN

Dubai, UAE

The task for the interior design was to keep existing furniture as much as possible with possibility to wrap some furniture with another decors or colors and to make new furniture arrangement so that the space is more practical to use. Interior design suggests ideas for kitchen, entrance hall and new colors palette for whole space. Interior design consists of mostly green and beige pastel colors, with a lot of plants involved around. Since the apartment is located in desert climate the main inspiration was to make little 'oaza' in the apartment, so that people who live in it have impression that they are surrounded by nature or that they feel touch of forest in it.







APARTMENT INTERIOR DESIGN

Velika Kladuša, Bosnia and Herzegovina

The aim of the project was to create a modern, functional apartment in the spirit of minimalism, but at the same time allowing you to feel a home atmosphere. The nature of the interior, dominated by geometric shapes and clean lines, aims to achieve subdued elegance, tasteful details, play with colors and contrasts with the use of noble materials. The elements that unite the space are the oak floor and vertical wooden slats in the living room and dining room, which visually separate the zones while enhancing the coherent character of the interior.

The floor is finished with an oiled oak plank combined with porcelain tiles in the hall, kitchen and bathroom. The living room has been optically and functionally connected with the dining room and kitchen with bar table, so that all spaces are connected through big open space.

In the kitchen, the wall from floor to ceiling has been arranged with furniture, except for the part below window. Additionally, the working space is enlarged by an island attached to the wall, separating the kitchen area from the living room. The colors of the fronts are based on warm white and white marble stone combined with the wood of the top.
