# 01 BOUTIQUE HOTEL PROJECT

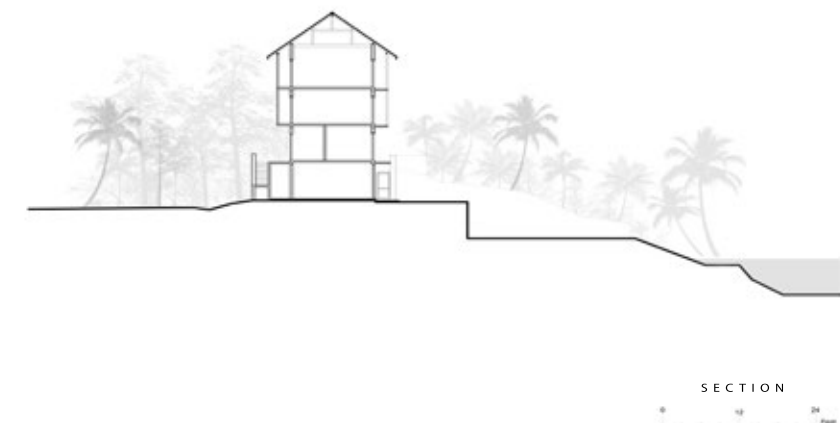
As jarring as 'regeneration' may sound, that's precisely what Architect Amila Liyanapathirana did so flawlessly when he was sought to build a boutique hotel in the cool climes of Kithulgala right on the edge of a rainforest.

Moksha is a hotel built for repose and healthful living, of life embedded in nature. While it offers all the creature comforts in the likes of a star hotel in its interior, Moksha's exterior structure and ambience blend themselves seamlessly into the natural landscape it is built into.

The name "Moksha," derived from the Sanskrit word meaning "to be free," is an apt descriptor of the concept that this boutique hotel embodies. Holistically, the hotel provides luxurious comfort while lending the guest the opportunity to stay attuned to nature's subtle nuances: of flowing water in the nearby creek, of crickets deep in the jungle, and of cool breeze that sweeps the forest.

It has taken nearly a year to prepare the land for construction, as it has been full of boulders that one always meets in the proximity of natural waterways and woodlands. Set in the private woodland's innermost edge, the guest is offered the soothing experience of driving through verdant yards of the forest to arrive at the premises.

The visitor driving the last leg of a long journey, who is met with greenery first, is then greeted by the spectacular sculpture of an Eagle welcoming them. The eagle, symbolic of freedom and wise perseverance, gives the first glimpse of the stay experience at Moksha, Kithulgala. As the guests arrive at the lobby, they are offered the comfortable contrast of a wide area to relax and stretch themselves after being cooped in a small space.







Sparse.

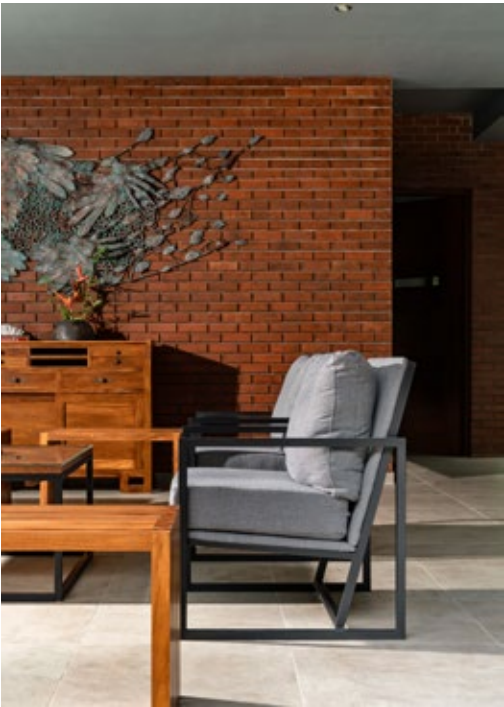
We commissioned the furniture to be designed with less detail, to serve its purpose and to serve its purpose only. We wanted to let the furniture, built of steel and wood in earthy tones to blend into the background as the guest experiences the natural simplicity that Moksha offers.



Spatial.

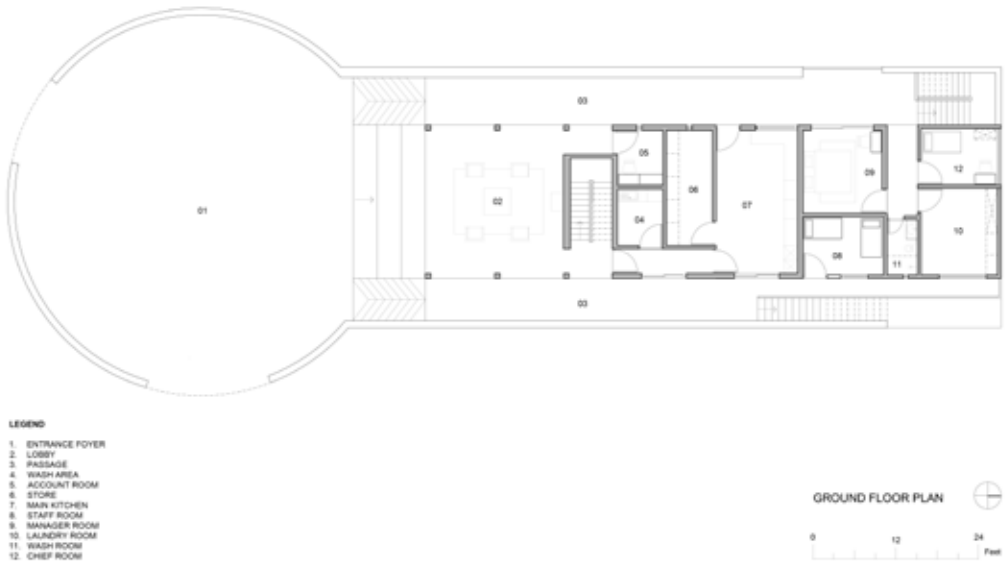
The restaurant is open 270 degrees and affords verdant views of greens nearby and hills in the far distance. The structure encourages an open floor plan, where the guests can dine, one with nature. We used simple, unadorned wooden furniture to add to the theme of natural simplicity that runs throughout the property



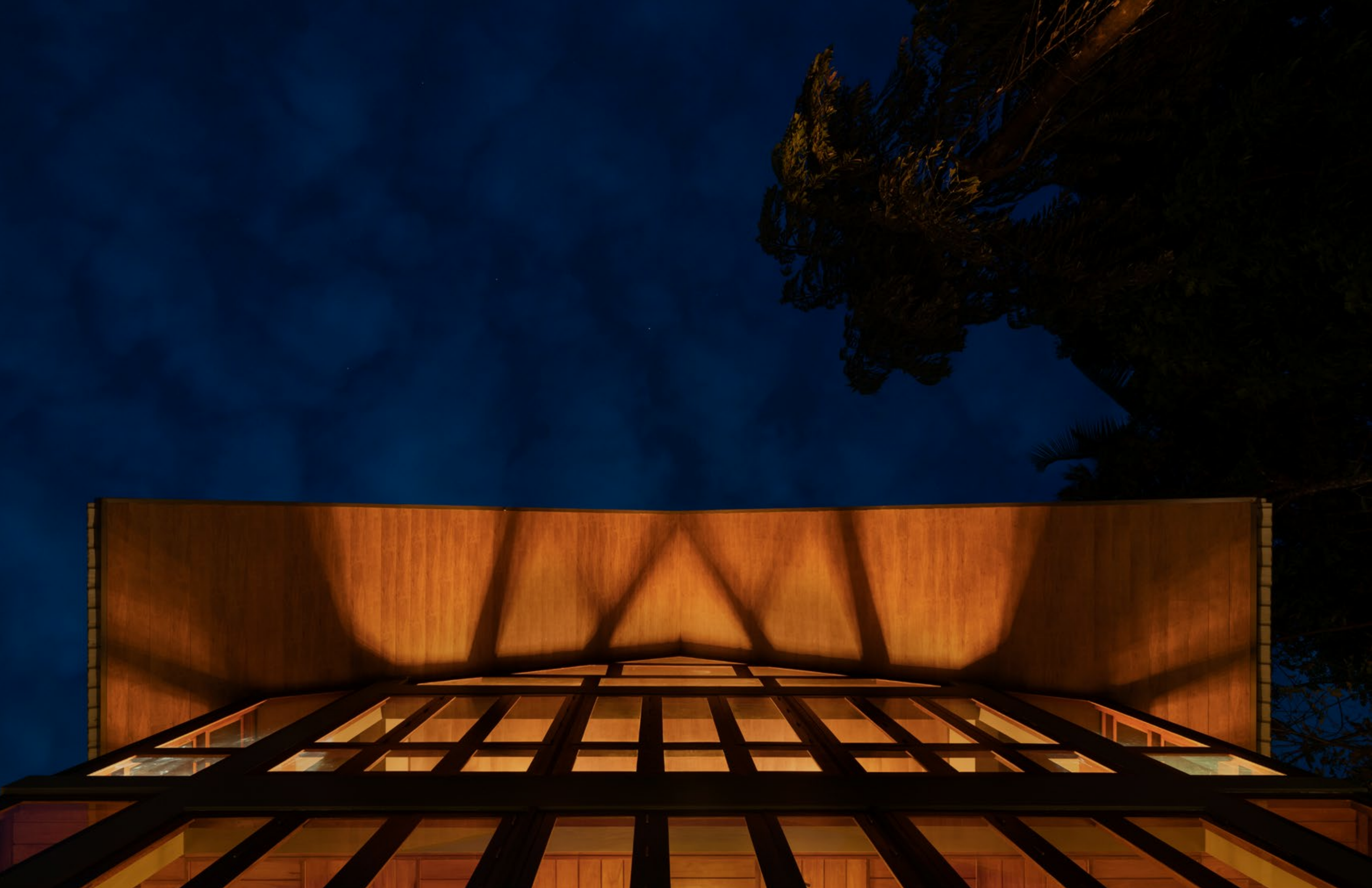


Scenic.

The windows are nothing but a wooden frame and clear glass. We intended to offer an uninterrupted view of what's outside, the refreshing leafy greens and yellows and the picturesque views of hills beyond. This was in keeping with the boutique hotel's architectural experience.

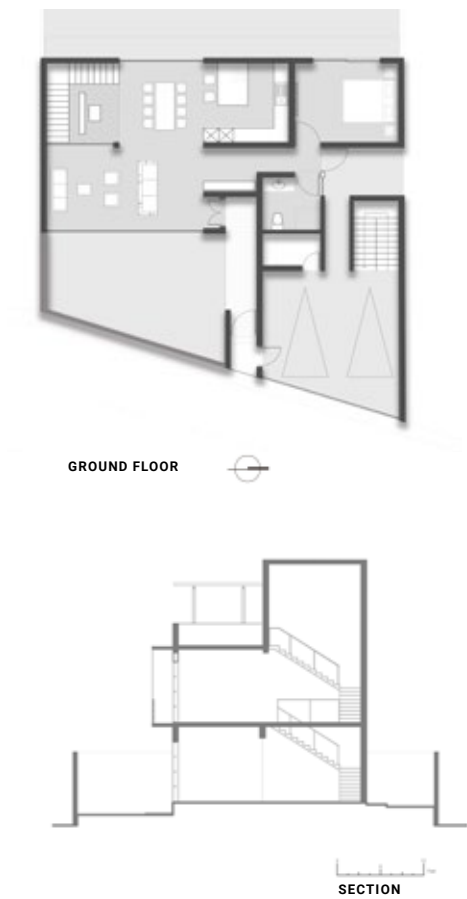

The project intends to bring an alternative approach to the conception of middle range Sri Lankan urban house, combining tropical architectural principles, quality material solutions and contemporary design, the residence adheres to environmental and microclimatic philosophies to enhance the architectural design

Moreover, the use of Ivory coloured tile floors inside, coupled with elements made of timber have enhanced interior illumination while creating a minimalistic yet pleasant atmosphere. The use of vertical timber screens for some of the bedroom windows ensures privacy for the user while also providing the space with unhindered natural ventilation



The arrangement of the house and its spaces made the inside-outside spaces flow into one another, giving the impression of larger spaces. The main materials used in the design were Timber and steel so that maximum light was brought in. Although the plot size was small, there was landscaping designed towards the north exterior, so that there would be privacy and views for the upper floors, whereas, on the ground floor, the plants serves as a backdrop for the lobby space and the sitting area.





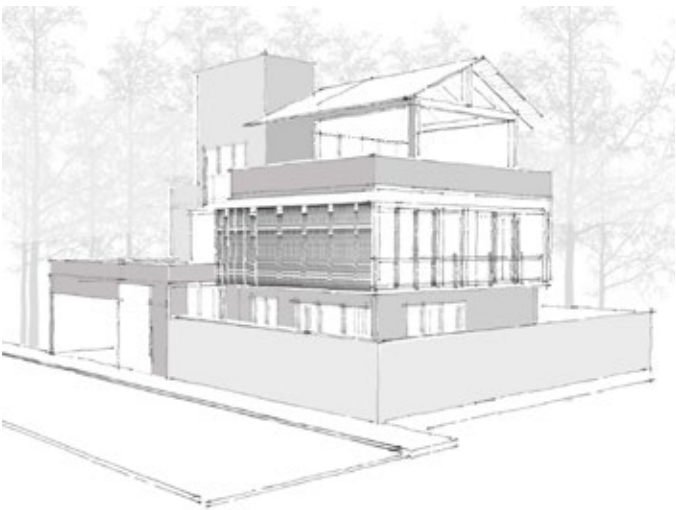

Portraying the language of tropical Modern Villa type, this design draws inspiration from the notion of simplicity that climaxes at the zenith of sophisticated complexity. The design is composed of pure geometry and lucid lines creating simple flowing spaces that are devoid of unnecessary ornamentation. The simple robust form adhering to a subdued natural colour palette not only creates an overall monastic ambience by its muted whiteness during the day; but also acts as a house of fete and entertainment at night.

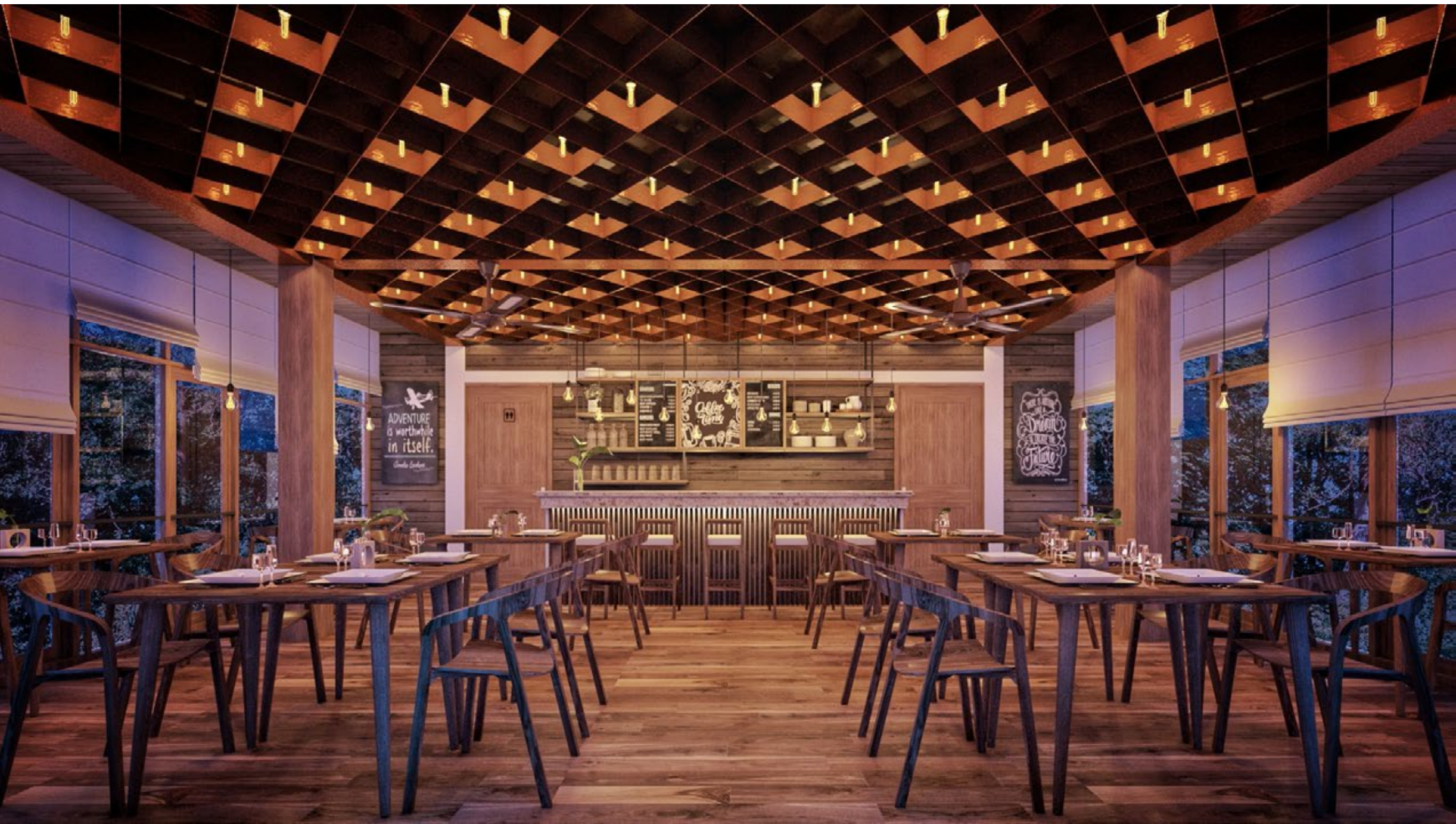
