


Principal of Corso: Connecting the inner part of the city to the gates (Territory Outside the Ancient City)\*






For more flow and passage ways from different part of the plots, paths are subtracted from the exisisting block.








**P**roposal suggests to create a multifunctional center, that through it's content explores the fast fashion issue deeper.




The Farini railway yard represent one of the largest area for transformation of the railway system under decommissioning.










The structure is one of hanging cables that hold most of the building. It is composed of the massive cores and large upper slab from which the aforementioned cables hang from. Another vital component however is the usage of columns, particularly to allow the free-standing central atrium and auditorium. It is aligned to these spaces so as to avoid incoherence between them and grants a clearer understanding of the solid and void components of the building, as well as the architectural and structural workings through the whole.









Ground floor


