- Increased Vegetation helps improve the micro-climate and thermal comfort. Grass acts as a natural coolant. Trees and grass absorb carbon dioxide, remove dust and smoke, and release oxygen resulting in improved Air Quality.
- Providing Native plants saves water and are sustainable (low water bills).
- Use of Concrete for the skate park - High thermal Mass - It absorbs heat from the atmosphere during the day (warm weather) and releases at night (cold weather).
- Use of Solar Panel parking are energy efficient, cost savings and Eco-friendly.
- Adding vegetation lowers stress and blood pressure resulting in increased productivity of the employees giving employees a morale boost and reducing levels of cortisol.







RESTAURANT PROJECT - TECHNICAL








- Creating a setting where those struggling with addiction don't feel like they're in a hospital.

- Use of plants and grass will be used as they assist in having a calm mood and a positive behaviour.
- Yoga, art therapy and few indoor activities would be available in the program to keep the patient's mind occupied in order for a quicker recovery.
- At the centre, there will be a recreational space that will be common area for the patients to bond and connect with each other.
- All the medical and therapy rooms will be closer to the entrance for the detoxification process. The first thing to do is get a medical checkup to determine if there are drugs in the system or not.
