Since the past, Yedikule has been a migration area and today, **digital nomads** continue this nomadic life culture. For this reason, digital nomads were chosen as the target group within the scope of the project, and a high-level communal living space was created in the building thanks to project-specific designs such as movable walls.

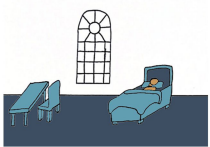


Ground Floor Plan



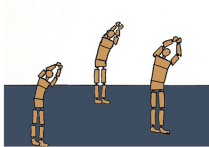

A design that can be transformed from single private rooms into shared rooms for multiple people, thanks to movable wall panels.



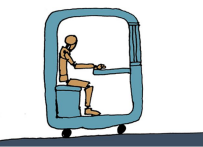
Social Events Together

Workpods designed to meet the need for a quiet and private work space for online business meetings and some works that requires focus.



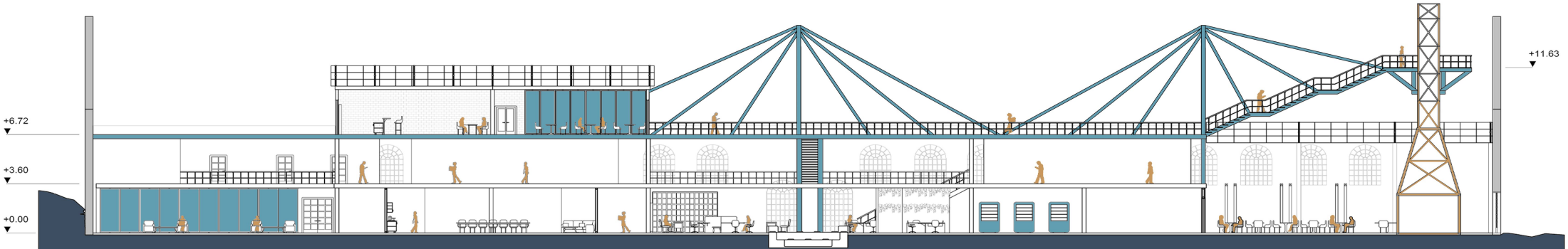
Relaxing at Cafe

The chimney of the historical gasworks, which was redesigned as a viewing tower and designated as a point of attraction.

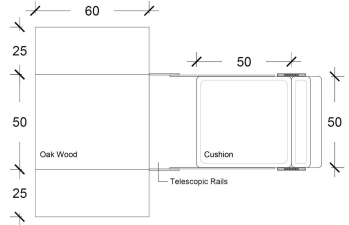

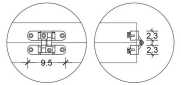
Side Elevation

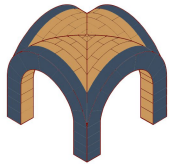
Ground Floor Plan

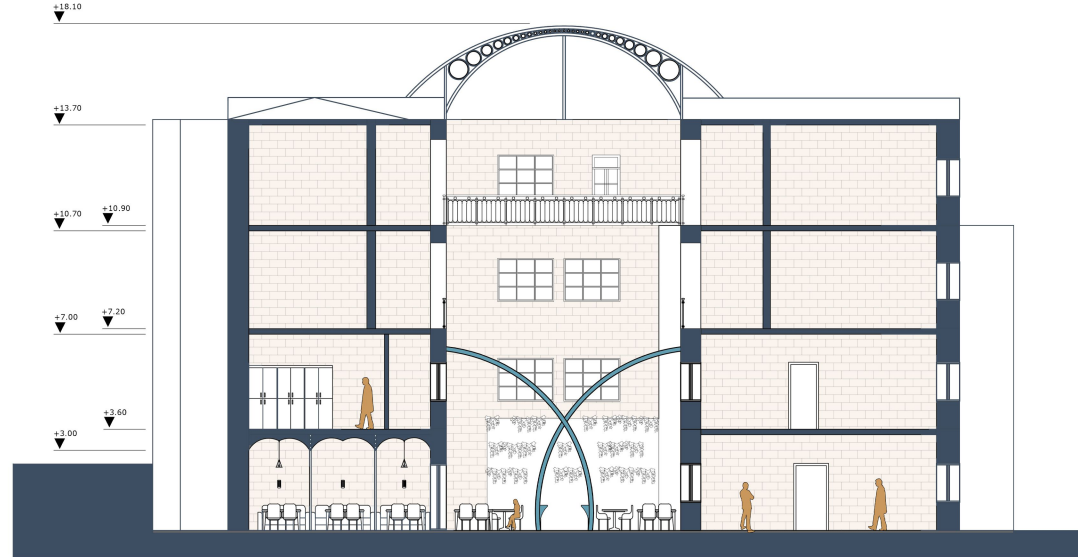
Vault Abstraction

A ceiling design inspired by vaults, a common architectural element of the Byzantine, Genoese and Ottoman periods.



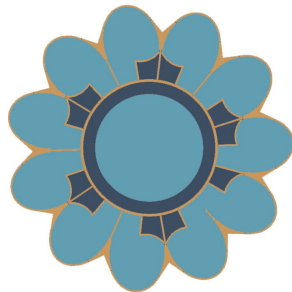
Arch Abstraction

A design inspired by vaults, a common architectural element of the Byzantine, Genoese and Ottoman, that serves as both lighting and separation for the courtyard.



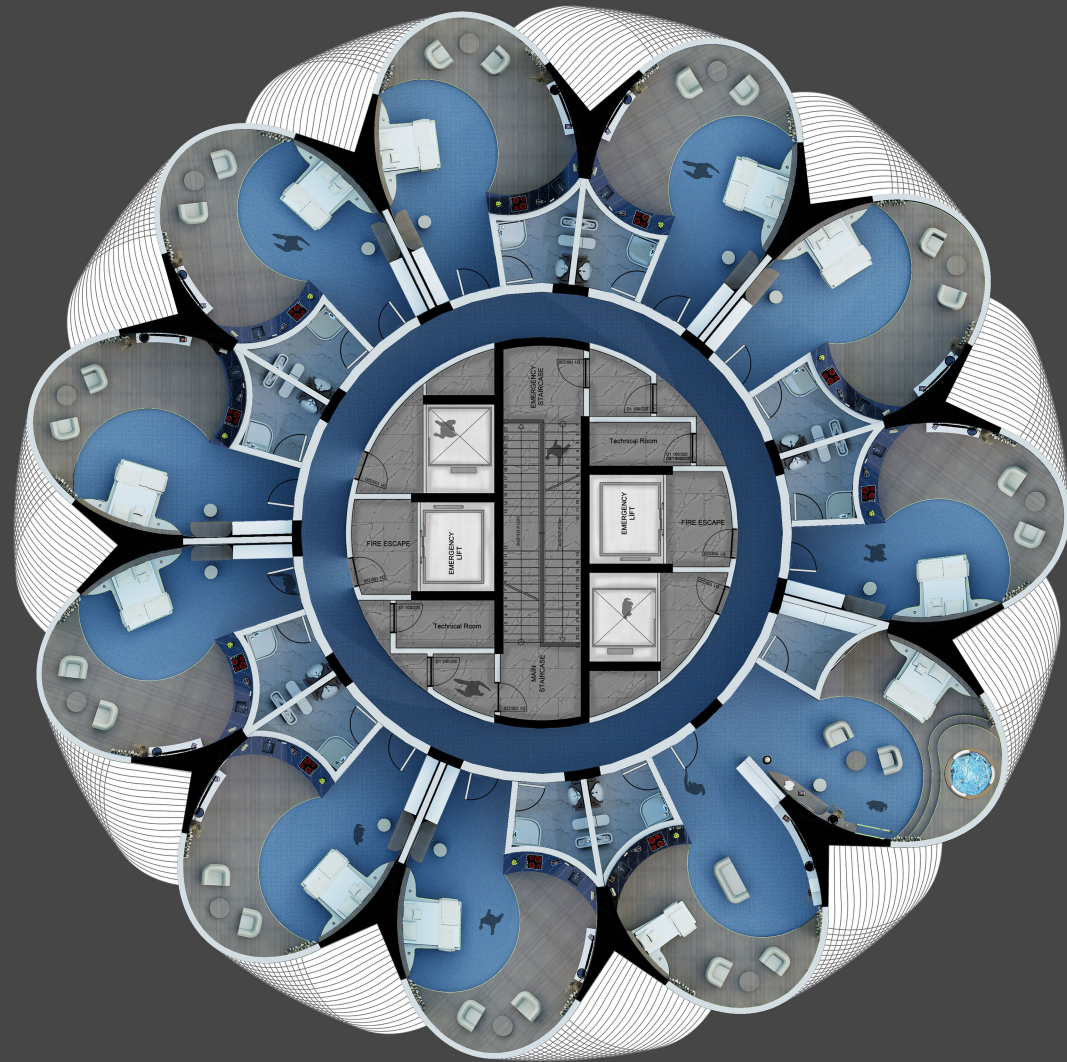

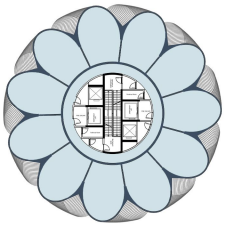

Interior design of the **35-storey hotel**, designed by Sanat Proje Mimarlık to rise from the ground to the sky in a **spiral shape**. The **spiral design** concept, which can be easily seen in the structure and exterior of the building, is reflected to the **interior design** of the hotel's rooms in a way that visitors can feel.

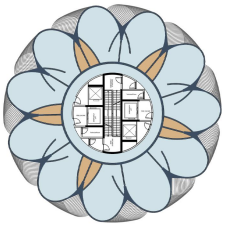




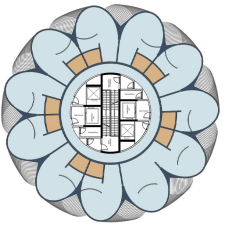
Design Process



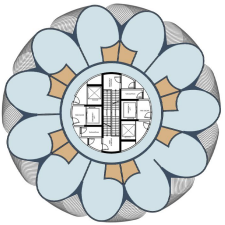
Stage 1: Empty plan without interior layout.



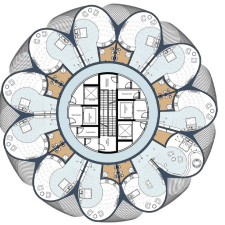
Stage 2: An attempt at plan division where the outline of the building is continued inside.



Stage 3: An interior plan partitioning attempt with less dead space.



Stage 4: A new plan division that is simpler and in harmony with the plan of the building.



Stage 5: Plan layout designed according to the final partitioning decided.

Photorealistic images from the interior design of the suite rooms of hotel. An elevation on the ground compatible with the building's spiral concept and a jacuzzi embedded in the ground were designed.

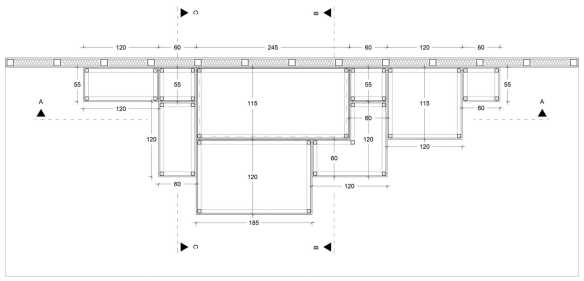
The project of transforming the **Art Deco** style Yumurcak Cinema building, which opened in Beşiktaş in 1939, into a cinema museum. Based on this, films shot in the years when the Art Deco style was widespread were researched. With the "**Forced Perspective**" technique frequently used in these films, images placed in strategic positions appear as a whole scene in the **camera's perspective**. Based on this technique as a concept, a layout plan with **different elevations** within the building was designed.



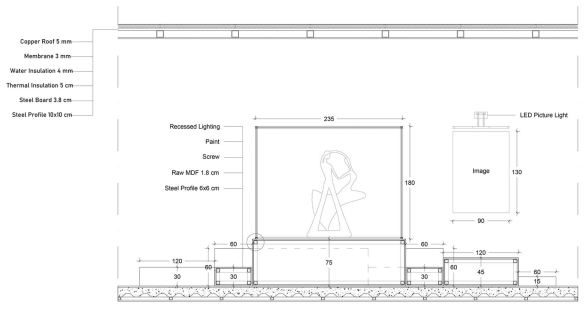

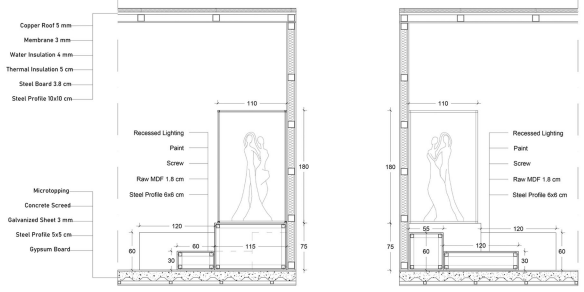

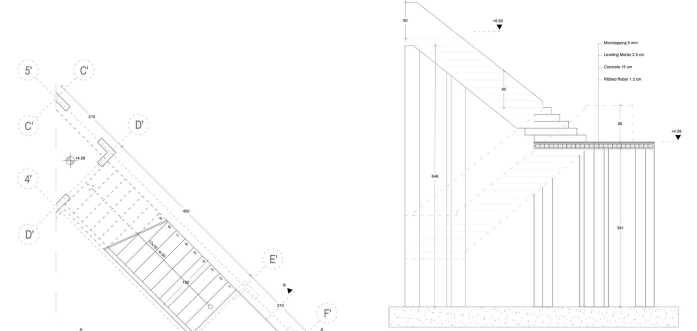

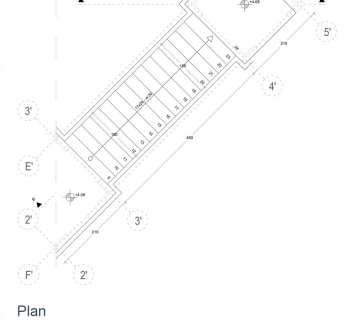

Stairs

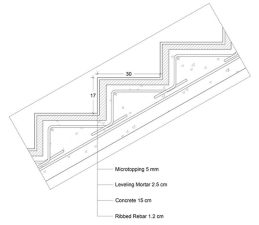
At the center of the layout plan with various elevations, a monumental staircase designed for both circulation and perceiving the space from different perspectives.



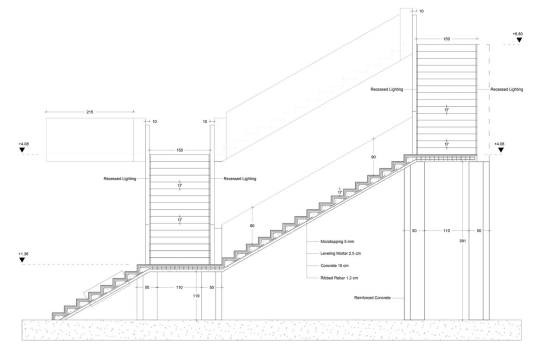
