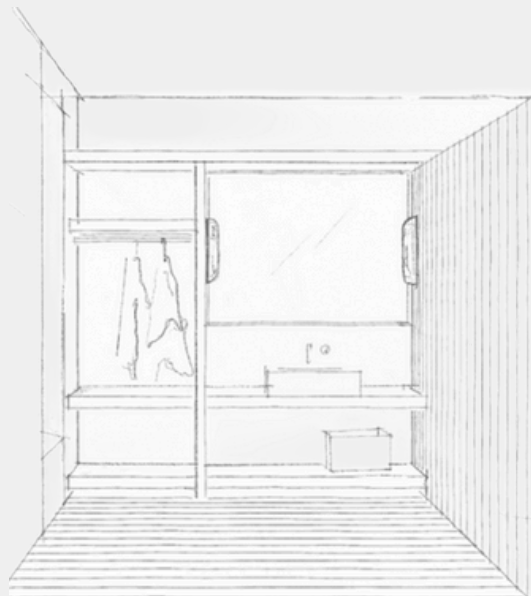

It is the second oldest house in the Roma neighborhood, restored to accommodate eight rooms filled with subtle details.

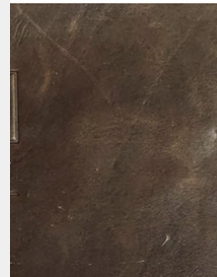
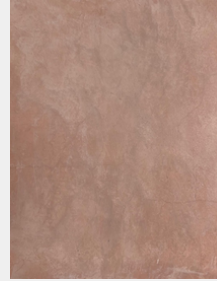
